Emergency Generator Acquisition and Installation

The City of Oelwein will be soliciting bids for the purchase and installation of one emergency building generator and associated items at the property located at 200 West Charles, Oelwein, Iowa. The project comprises of the following mandatory minimum items;

1. 32 KW natural gas generator with auto start.
2. Generator features: self-test mode – auto transfer switch - mobile link connectivity – db(A) at exercise = 56 – 60 db(A) normal operation range = 62 - 64
3. Load Requirement to Support Critical Functions During Power Outage: 30 KW
4. Generator foundation: Cement
5. Generator fuel lines: Black pipe.
6. All piping and electrical wiring necessary to complete installation.
7. All site work and associated costs/permits.
8. All costs of installation and purchase.
9. 5-year warranty.
